Many thanks for forwarding the response of the GMGU to the representations of William Sinclair Horticulture Ltd.

I would be grateful if you could ask the GMGU to comment as follows:

1. The GMGU states that Policy 6 has been developed in line with requirements of national Minerals Planning Policy and evidence used to inform NW RSS . Please could the GMGU explain in greater detail which national requirements are these? In addition, could the RSS evidence which contributed to Policy 6 be clarified.
2. The GMGU states that para 5.64 of the Plan is an accurate statement regarding the position on peat as set out within the North West according to the RSS. Please could this be clarified.

It would be very useful if the comments could be made available before the close of the final hearing session next week."
